

Stunning "1918 Flu" Experiment Proves Virus NOT Contagious

Considered to be one of the deadliest disasters in human history, the 1918 flu pandemic makes COVID-19 irrelevant.

The Test

In an attempt to devise a vaccine, medical authorities conducted tests on volunteers at a Naval prison on Deer Island in Boston Harbor. In exchange for a pardon, the prisoners agreed to go through a series of outlandish tests to determine how the flu spread. Prisoners were:

- ① **Sprayed** in the eyes, nose and mouth with **infected aerosols**.
- ② **Injected** with **infected lung tissue** from dead patients.
- ③ Then their throats were **swabbed** with **discharges from the sick and dying**.
- ④ Finally, they had to **sit open-mouthed while a sick patient coughed in their faces**.



The Result

NONE of the 62 volunteers contracted what was supposedly "the world's most deadly virus."

Many died in 1918 (and 2020) from various causes. But a contagious (and airborne) virus just wasn't one of them.
